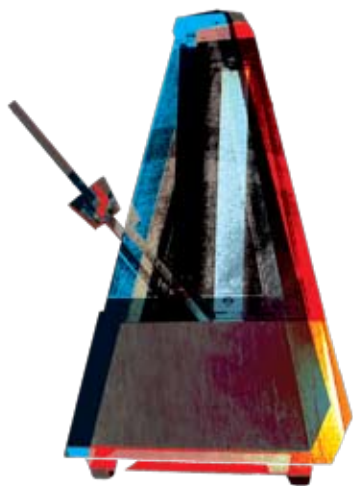


# The 2009 - 2010 Faculty Artist Series
